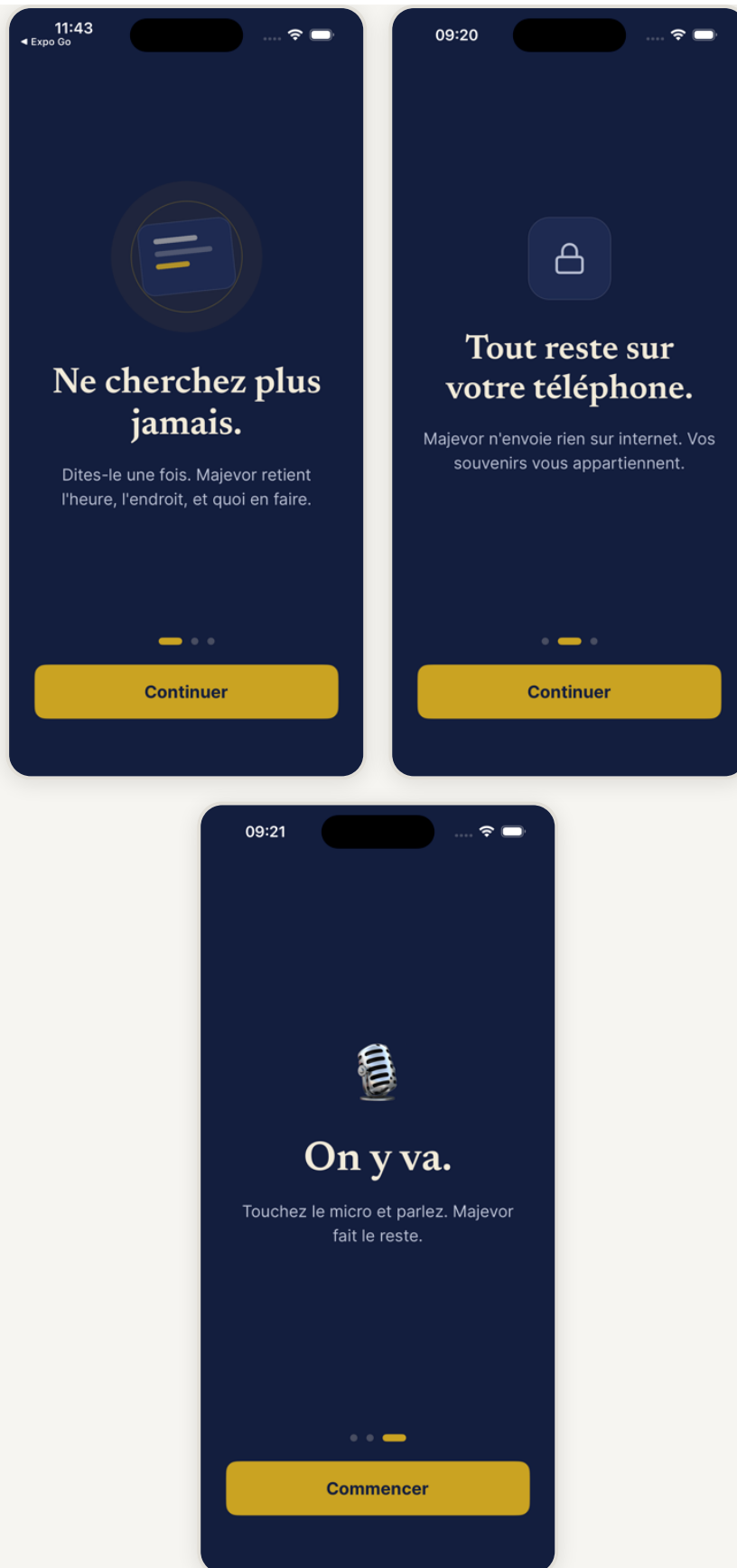
How to use Majevor: tap the microphone (or say « Hey Siri, [butler's name] »), then **speak naturally**. Majevor understands what you want to do and offers the right actions. No menu, no form.

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1. Getting started



On first launch, Majevor guides you through 3 screens:

1. What it does (remember, remind, act)
2. Everything stays on your phone (no data is sent)

3. Tap the microphone and speak

Majevor will ask for access to the **microphone** and to **speech recognition**. The other permissions (calendar, contacts, location, etc.) are requested **only when you actually need them**, not before.



💡 **Tip:** You can also type your text on the keyboard by tapping the text field below the microphone.

2. Making a call

Majevor searches your contacts and starts the call. If the contact doesn't exist, it offers to create it.

Call Corinne

→ Finds the contact Corinne, shows the **Call** button

Call 079 123 45 67

→ Detects the number, offers **Call** + **Create contact**

I need to call the mechanic

→ Call button (if the mechanic is in your contacts) + Remind me

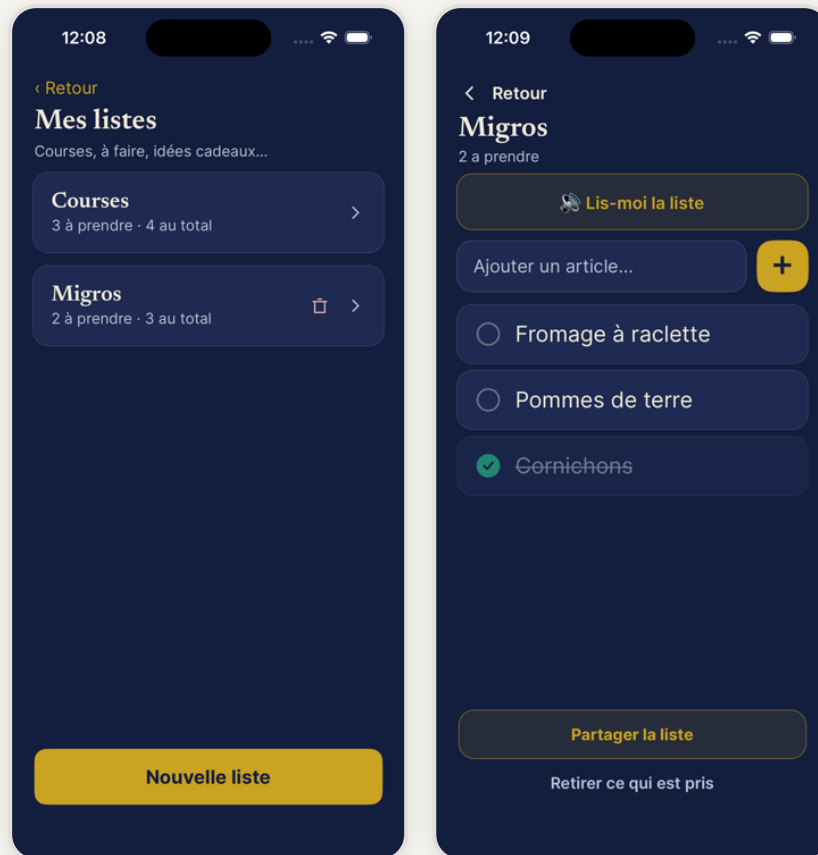
Make a phone call

→ Majevor asks you: « Who do you want to call? »

 **Tip:** If Majevor can't find the contact, it offers to create a card for it.



3. Shopping lists



Dictate your items naturally. Majevor splits the products, detects the quantities, and files them in the right list.

 **Buy bread, milk and eggs**

→ 3 items added to the « Shopping » list (the default)

 **Add butter and cream to the Migros list**

→ 2 items added to the « Migros » list

 **3 kilos of apples and 2 litres of milk**

→ Items added with the quantities kept

 **Add to Migros**

→ Majevor asks you: « What do you want to add? »

Managing lists

- **Multiple lists:** create as many lists as you want (Migros, Coop, Gift ideas...)
- **Checking off items:** tap an item to cross it out
- **Voice mode:** Majevor tells you how many are left (« Only 3 to go! »)
- **Read the list:** a button so Majevor reads all the remaining items out loud
- **Share:** send the list by SMS, WhatsApp, email, etc.

4. Appointments and calendar

Majevor creates the appointment in your iOS calendar, detects conflicts, and looks up the address in your contacts.

Dentist appointment tomorrow at 2 pm

→ Pre-filled card: title « Dentist », date = tomorrow, time = 2:00 pm

Doctor's appointment on Tuesday

→ Card with date = next Tuesday, time to be completed

Meeting at 10 am for the Müller project

→ Card with title « Müller project », time = 10:00 am

Appointment at Corinne's at 3 pm

→ Looks up Corinne's address in your contacts and adds it to the appointment

Checking your calendar

What do I have today?

→ Shows all of today's appointments

My calendar for Friday

→ Shows Friday's appointments

Cancel my appointment tomorrow

→ Opens tomorrow's calendar so you can cancel

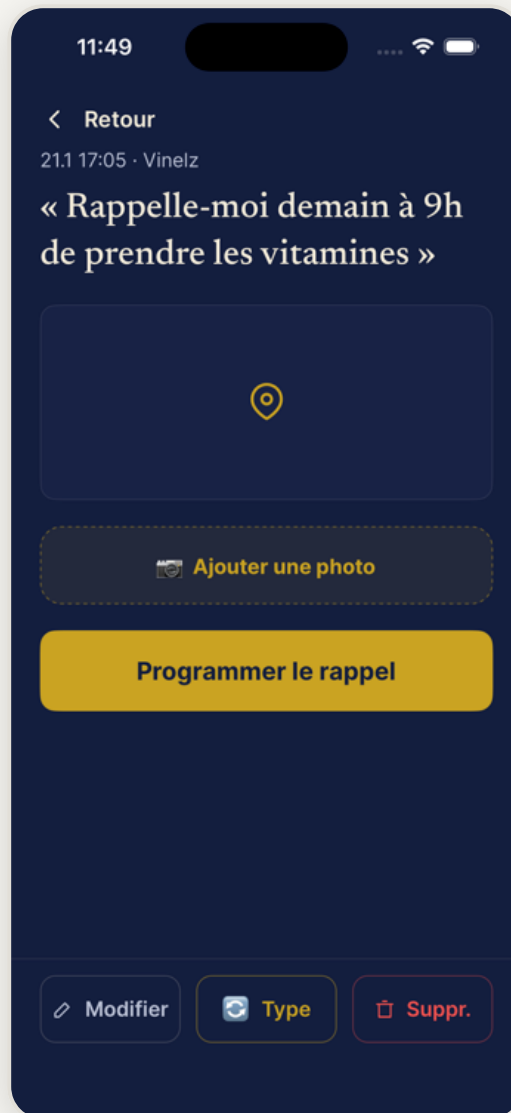
Advanced features

- **Conflict detection:** if you already have something at 2 pm, Majevor warns you and suggests the next free slot
- **Reminders:** alert 5, 15, 30 min or 1 hour before the appointment
- **Repeat:** daily, weekly, monthly
- **Context:** shows the appointment before and after, with the travel time



5. Reminders and timers

Majevor sets a notification for the time you ask for. It understands absolute times, relative times, and repeats.



One-off reminders



Remind me at 2:30 pm

→ Notification set for 2:30 pm



Remind me tomorrow morning

→ Notification tomorrow at 9:00 am

 **Remind me in 30 minutes**
→ Notification in exactly 30 minutes

 **Remind me in half an hour to take the cake out**
→ Notification in 30 min with the message

 **Remind me to take my medication**
→ Majevor asks you: « At what time? »

Recurring reminders

 **Remind me every morning to take my vitamins**
→ Daily reminder at 8:00 am (the word « morning » is enough)

 **Remind me every Monday at 9 am**
→ Weekly reminder every Monday at 9:00 am

 **Remind me every day to take out the bins**
→ Majevor asks you: « At what time? » then sets the reminder

Timer (parking, cooking, etc.)

 **Parking until 4 pm**
→ Alert 10 min before 4 pm + GPS location of the car



6. Sending an email

Majevor drafts a message from what you dictate. The AI writes a polite, well-structured email. You review it and send it.



Write an email to Pierre

→ Opens the Mail screen with « Pierre » as the recipient



Write to Marc that I'll be late

→ Email to Marc, subject and body generated by the AI



Send Julie an email to confirm Tuesday's appointment

→ Draft with subject « Confirming Tuesday's appointment » and pre-written text



Tip: You can regenerate the draft if the wording doesn't suit you, or edit it before sending.



7. Taking a note

Anything Majevor doesn't file under another area becomes a **note**. It's the safety net: nothing gets lost.



The gate code is 4582

→ Saved as a note with the title « Gate code — 4582 »



Remember to buy a present for Lea's birthday

→ Note saved, findable through search



The plumber is coming Thursday between 10 and 12

→ Note with the detected date, can be turned into an appointment

Named notes

You can create **notes with a specific title** to come back to them and add content over time. It's ideal for idea lists, ongoing projects, or anything you build up little by little.



Note Holidays: book the hotel

→ Creates the « Holidays » note with the first item « book the hotel »



Note Holidays: buy the plane tickets

→ Adds « buy the plane tickets » to the existing « Holidays » note



Add to my Holidays note: pack the suitcases

→ Adds another item to the « Holidays » note



Tip: The syntax is always: **Note [title]: [content]** or **Add to my note [title]: [content]**. If the note already exists, Majevor adds to it automatically. Otherwise, it creates it.

Note features

- **Photo:** attach a photo (receipt, prescription, licence plate, etc.)
- **Location:** each note is geo-tagged automatically
- **Search:** find any note by keyword

- **Archive:** move a note to the archives (recoverable)
- **Change type:** convert a note into a reminder, an appointment, etc.



8. Creating a contact

Dictate a number or an email, Majevor detects it and offers to create the contact card.

 **079 123 45 67**

→ Detects the number, offers Create contact / Call / Copy

 **Marc's number is 079 123 45 67**

→ Card with « Marc » + number, Create contact button pre-filled

 **Julie's email is julie@mail.ch**

→ Create contact + Copy email buttons



9. Finding your car

Majevor saves your GPS location and brings you back to it later.



My car is parked here

→ GPS location saved, « Take me there » button (opens Maps)



Parked on level 3, space B12

→ Saves the location + level 3 + space B12



Parking until 4 pm

→ GPS location + alert before 4 pm



10. Recording an amount

Majevor detects amounts in Swiss francs and saves them.



Pierre owes me 50 francs

→ Note with the detected amount (50 CHF), Copy button



The repair costs 350 francs

→ Note with 350 CHF, copyable



The rent is 1500 bucks

→ Detects « bucks » as Swiss francs (1500 CHF)



11. Navigating to an address

 ***Rue de Lausanne 42 Biel***

→ Detects the address, « Open route » button (Google Maps)

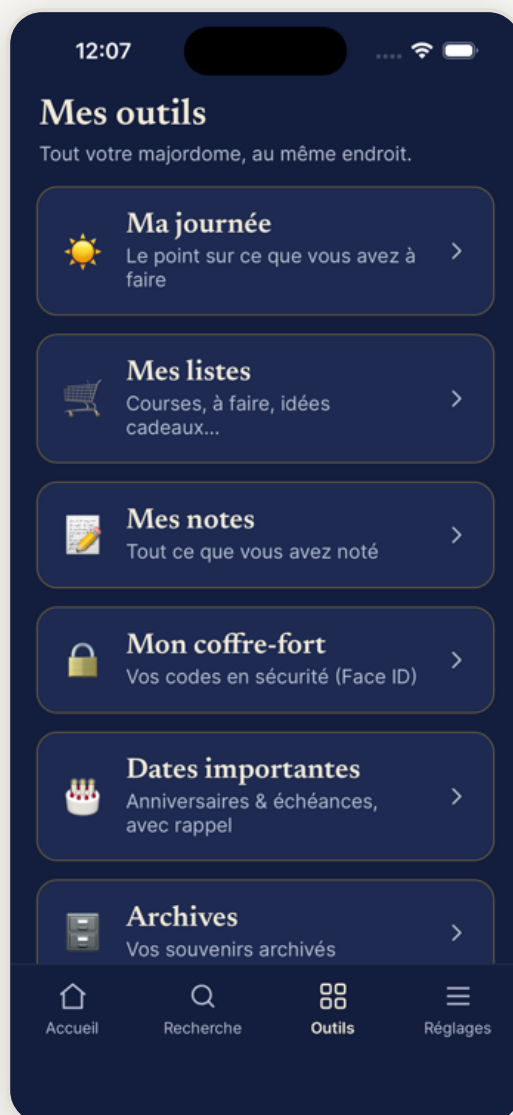
 ***Avenue de la Gare 15 Neuchâtel***

→ Opens GPS navigation to that address

 ***Chemin des Vignes 7***

→ Address detected, route button

12. Vault



Store your sensitive codes and secrets, protected by **Face ID / Touch ID**. The data is encrypted in your iPhone's security chip (Secure Enclave) — not even Majevor can access it without your face or your fingerprint.

How to open it

From the **Tools** screen (bottom tab), tap **Vault**. Face ID is triggered automatically.

What you can store

- Door, gate or alarm code
- Suitcase, padlock or locker code
- Serial number, order reference
- Any sensitive text you want to protect

Features

- **Add:** title + secret (free text)
- **Show/hide:** tap to reveal temporarily
- **Copy:** copies to the clipboard
- **Delete:** with confirmation

 **Tip:** The vault is never backed up to iCloud and disappears if you reset your iPhone without a transfer.

13. My day

A summary of your day: appointments, active reminders, recent notes. Available from the **Tools** screen.



(Notification at 6 am)

→ « Good morning! » — tap to see your day

What you'll find there

- Your appointments for today, tomorrow and the day after
- Your active reminders
- A spoken summary (Majevor reads your day out loud)
- An AI briefing (if the built-in model is available)



14. Important dates

Birthdays, yearly deadlines, dates you mustn't forget. Majevor reminds you on the day (and a week before if you want).

How to add one

From **Tools** → **Important dates**, tap **+**.

- **Reminder on the day:** notification at 9:00 am
- **Reminder a week before:** optional notification 7 days ahead
- **Yearly recurrence:** the year is optional (if filled in, Majevor works out the age)

15. Voice search



The **Search** screen (bottom tab, magnifying-glass icon) digs through **everything Majevor knows**: your notes, appointments, reminders, shopping, important dates, vault, and even your iOS calendar.

Voice search

Tap the **microphone button** (to the right of the search field). Majevor listens and fills in the field as you speak. You can also type on the keyboard.

 **(Tap the mic) Dentist**

→ Shows every note, appointment and reminder containing « dentist »



(Tap the mic) Holidays

→ Finds the note named « Holidays », the linked appointments, the shopping items, etc.

Where Majevor searches

The search covers all your Majevor memories — notes, reminders, appointments, shopping lists, important dates, amounts and places — as well as your iOS calendar. Type or dictate a keyword (a name, a place, a topic): Majevor brings up everything that matches, grouped by type.

Filter by type

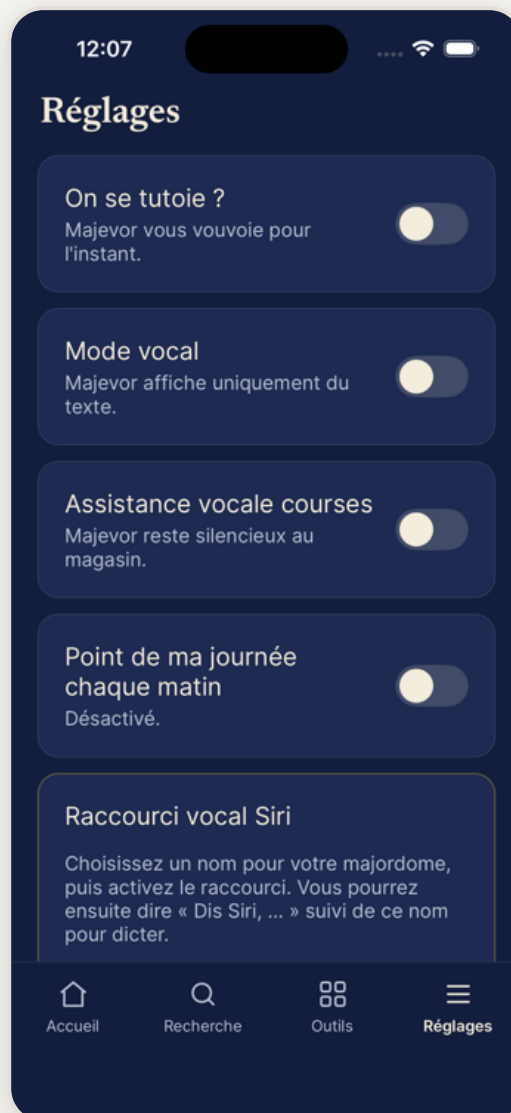
The filter chips at the top (All, Notes, Reminders, Appointments...) let you narrow the results down to Majevor memories of a single type.



Tip: Voice search uses on-device recognition — nothing is sent over the internet. Tap the mic a second time to stop.



16. Settings



From the **Settings** tab (at the bottom), you customise Majevor. A small « i » next to each setting opens a detailed explanation.

- **Language:** Automatic (follows your iPhone), or French / German / English.
- **Destination calendar:** which iOS calendar Majevor saves your appointments to (handy if you have several calendars).
- **Back up my data:** exports your memories to a readable file (text + JSON) to keep in Files or Notes.
- **Back up / restore the vault:** an encrypted export of the vault, protected by a password you choose.
- **Majevor speaks:** Majevor confirms out loud what it understood and did.
- **Voice shopping:** Majevor announces the number of items left in your lists.
- **Review the tutorial:** relaunch the getting-started guide at any time.

- **Reminders in alarm mode:** on recent iPhones, a reminder rings like an alarm clock and cuts through Silent mode; you choose the ringtone.
- **Morning briefing:** a notification that sums up your day.
- **Learning:** Majevor remembers your corrections and your vocabulary (can be turned off).
- **Cloud AI fallback:** turns on cloud mode (off by default; see section 19).
- **Cloud requests:** your gauge of this month's cloud requests, and access to plans and top-ups.
- **Siri shortcut:** give your butler a name to call it through Siri.
- **Erase my data:** permanently deletes all your memories from the device (irreversible).

17. Shortcuts and widget

Siri shortcut

In the settings, give your butler a name (e.g. « Albert »). Then simply say:

 *Hey Siri, Albert*

→ Majevor opens straight into dictation mode

Home screen widget

Add the Majevor widget to your home screen. One tap opens dictation instantly.

Lock screen widget

A small golden microphone on the lock screen. Tap it to dictate without even unlocking.

Long press on the icon

Press and hold the Majevor icon → « Dictate » for quick access.



18. Automatic learning

Majevor gets better with every use, **without sending any data**.

Correction

If speech recognition gets it wrong (e.g. « Dupont » heard as « du pont »), correct the text. Majevor remembers the correction and applies it automatically next time.

Vocabulary

Majevor learns the words you use often and passes them to speech recognition so it understands you better next time (proper nouns, technical terms, etc.).

19. Cloud mode (optional)

By default, everything works **locally** on your phone. If you turn on cloud mode:

- **What is sent:** only the sentence you dictate + your dictionary of frequent words
- **Where:** Infomaniak, a **sovereign Swiss host**, over an encrypted connection
- **Benefit:** better understanding, especially for complex sentences
- **What NEVER leaves the device:** your notes, contacts, calendar, photos, vault, GPS location

 **Tip:** Cloud mode is off by default. You have to turn it on deliberately in the settings.
